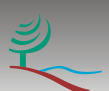

**PROGRAMME  
(PROVISIONAL)**

We propose 3 sessions of half of a day with discussion and debates at the end of each session, followed by a synthetic session for conclusions.

A one-day excursion is envisaged for Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> November to sheep and goat farms.

**15<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER**

**Session 1: *Evaluation of sheep and goat farming systems and indicators of sustainability***

*Papers from the working group on evaluation; evaluation of pastoral systems, etc.*

**Session 2: *The role of sheep and goat production systems in natural protected areas***

*Co-existence with wild species (wolf, bear), shrub control and risk of fire, preservation of endemic plants and deterioration of potentiality of pasture*

16<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER

**Session 3:** *Attractiveness of sheep and goat farming activities and assessment of their economic valorization*

*Labour organisation, multi-activities (tourism, preservation of environment, local handicrafts), valorisation of local products (organic, protected denomination of origin - PDO - commercial organisation, etc.) and training.*

## CALL FOR PAPERS AND SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Papers should be written in French or English. Abstracts (no more than 200 words) should be sent by 30<sup>th</sup> of April 2007.

All papers will be peer reviewed and, if accepted, they will be published in a special issue of the CIHEAM journal, *Options Méditerranéennes*.

The organization may also have its own publication.

At least, one author per paper must be registered in the Seminar.

## REGISTRATION FEES

There will be two different registration types:

1. Delegate: 200€ before 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2007 and 250€ afterwards.  
The fee includes: participation in the scientific programme, coffees, three lunches, two dinners, technical field trip and the proceedings of the Seminar.
2. Accompanying person: 120€ before 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2007 and 135€ afterwards.  
The fee includes: participation in the tourist programme (two days), three lunches, two dinners and technical field trip.
